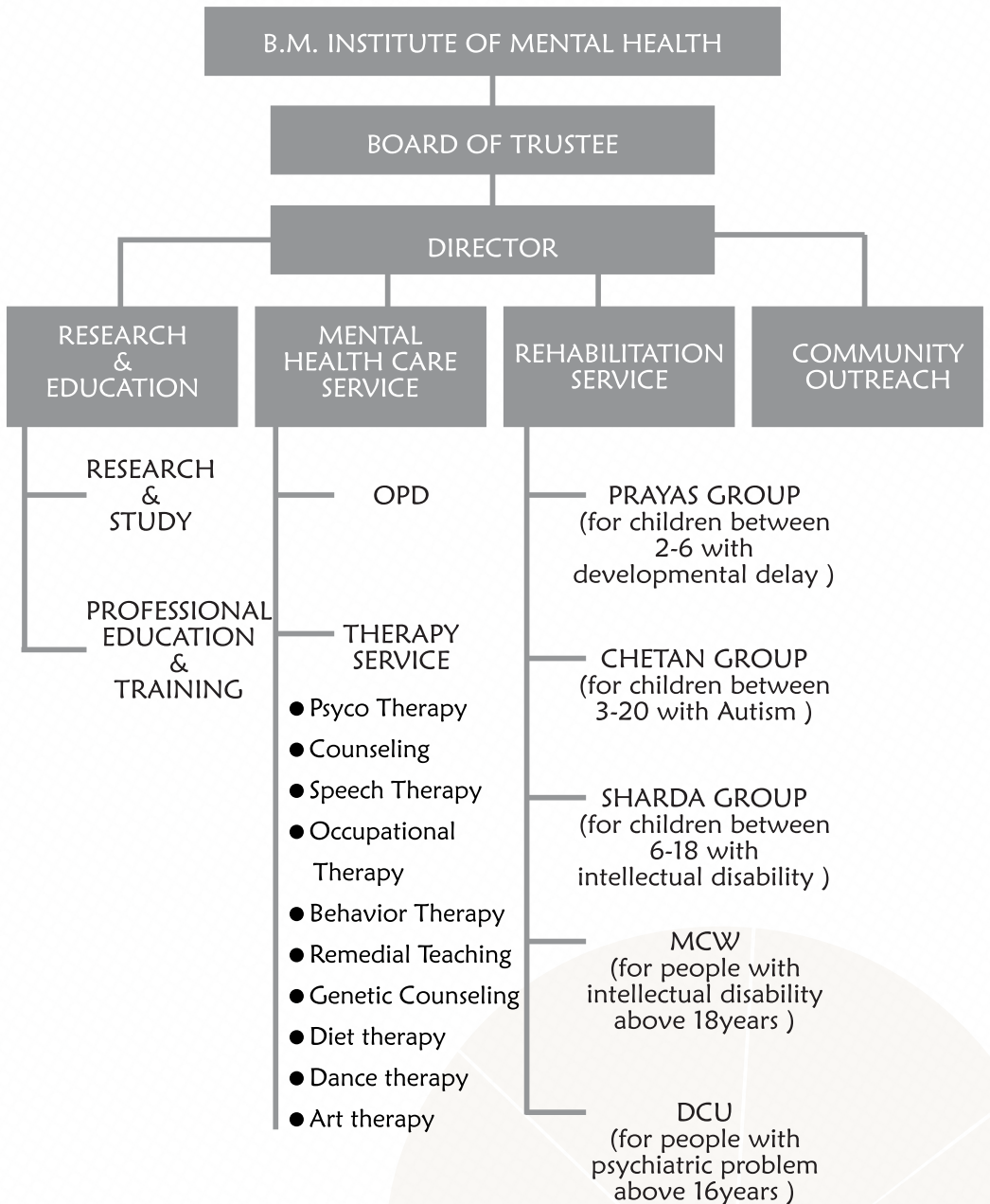

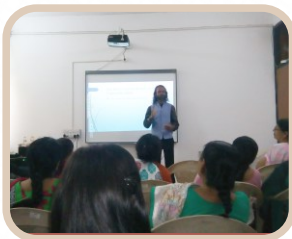

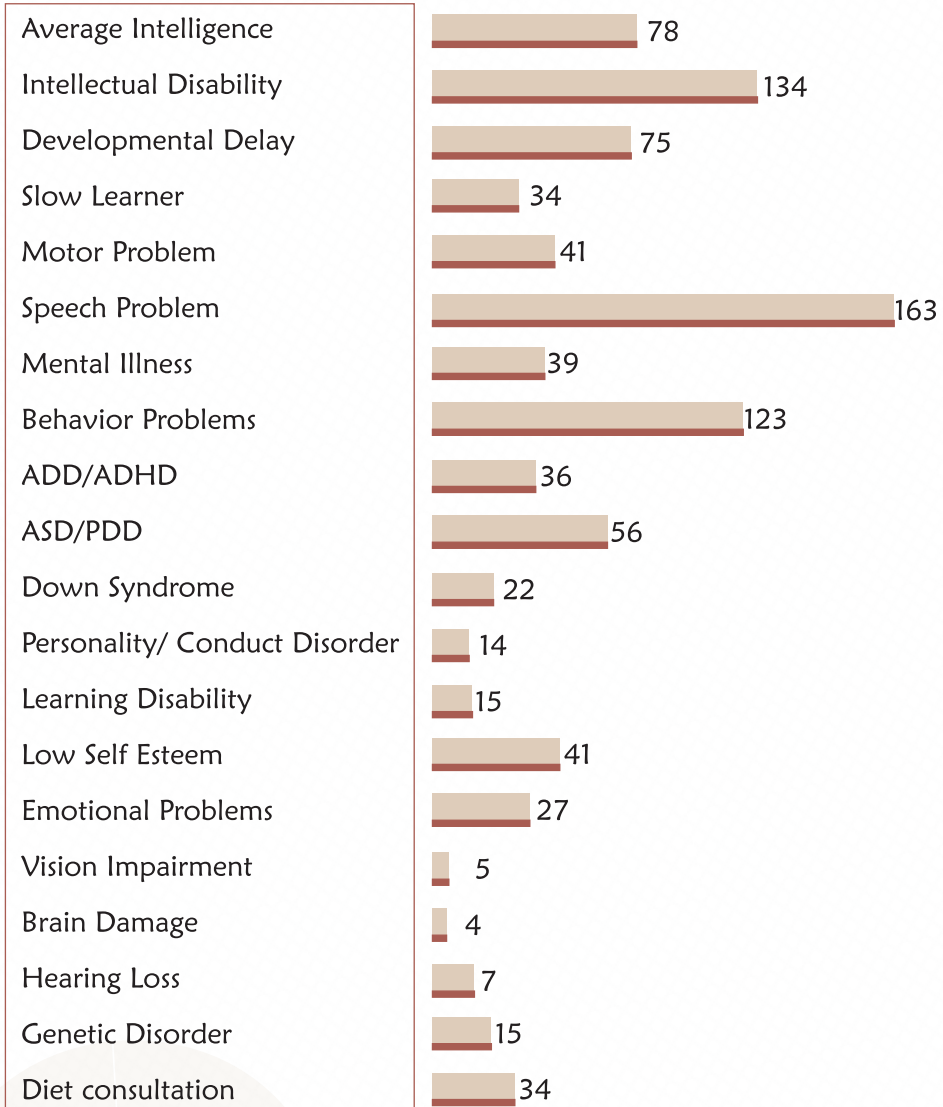
OPD: Entry gateway to the clinical services of the Institute for early identification of problems using multidisciplinary team approach.

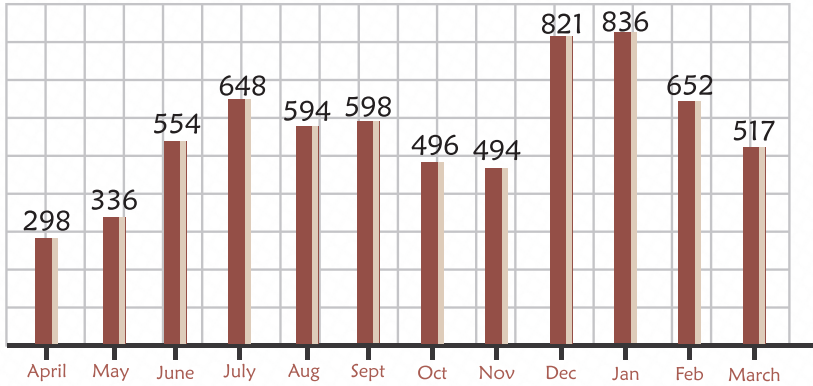
New registration of cases for multidisciplinary diagnostic work at OPD : 341



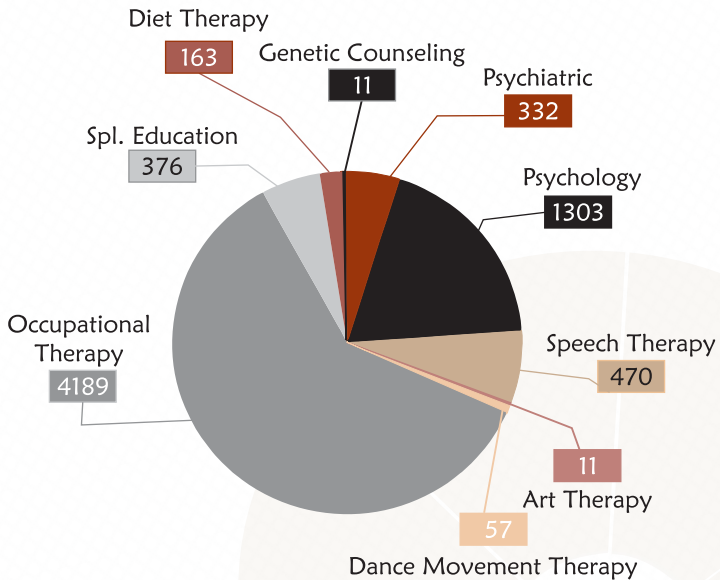
Type of cases attended at OPD During 2016-17

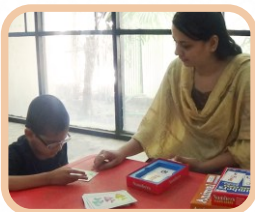

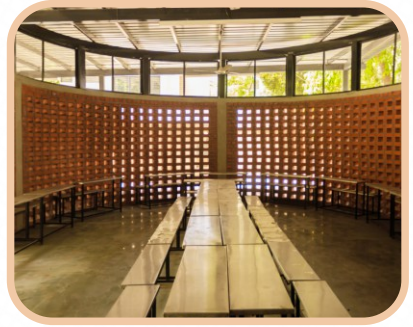

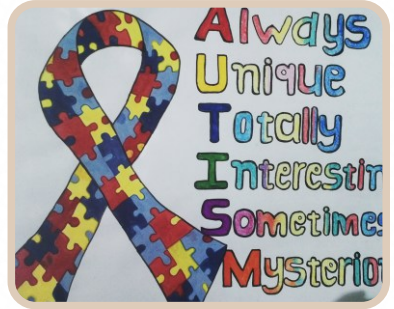
