


DIRECTOR'S DESK

2017 saw B M Institute of Mental Health complete 66 years of committed service to the society. Since its inception in 1951, the institute has endeavoured to bring positive change in the lives of people with mental health problems and special needs through its multifarious activities and human resource development. The year 2017-18 marked another significant period of accelerated efforts and momentous growth.



In the last three years especially, our focus has been on underlining and putting into action long-term goals that focus on holistic development of children and individuals with special abilities. This year alone our multi-disciplinary teamwork has resulted into making a discernible difference to the lives of more than 3000 children and adults. More than 7500 therapeutic sessions were conducted at the institute in Psychotherapy, Counselling, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Behaviour Modification, Remedial Teaching, Diet Therapy, Genetic Counselling etc.

As an organisation that spearheads the cause for equality for special population of India, we realise the need to be strategic in our approaches and utilisation of resources to maximise our impact. We have realigned the organisation to optimise our efforts with the updated Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016 and Mental Healthcare Act, 2017. To ensure our endurance, we have opened ourselves to many new ideas. Recent initiatives like Genetic Counselling, Sensory Integration Therapy, Dance Movement Therapy, Art Based Therapy and Diet Therapy have already started to take roots. A Biofeedback machine has been installed in the OPD for therapeutic intervention and research in the field.

The field of Research and Education has also been preparing for extensive growth in the coming year. The institute is preparing to start more professional courses in disability rehabilitation to train professionals for offering their services in Gujarat. In addition to ongoing professional training of students of Post Graduate Diploma in Rehabilitation Psychology, in 2017, approval has been granted to start one more professional training course- Advance Certificate Course in Inclusive Education Cross Disability- by RCI, New Delhi.

Professionals trained at B M Institute stand out in the field for their knowledge and commitment. A feather in the cap was added when the Gujarat State Higher Education Department awarded the institute during Grand Education Fair in 2017.

Lasting change is possible only when the entire community comes together to make it happen. BMIMH continues to play the role of a Community Partner in mobilising volunteers and empowering communities. Endeavours like sensitizing society for the cause of disability and mental health, consultancy to educational institutions for the rights of specially abled population, screening camps for early identification of mental health problems and disability have been among the highlights this year.

A significant focus of the year was an exercise to consolidate our identity to rise to the challenge of change. 18 new employees have been recruited to accelerate the ongoing work. New resources are continuously being added in the institute repository for research, education, training, assessment and therapeutic intervention.

As you read this report, you will sense a more collective process evolving in each of our efforts in 2017-18 that are in consonance with the values and practices we adhere to. I look forward to strengthening the ongoing services and spearhead new endeavours that ensure lasting change in the lives of people.

RESEARCH AND EDUCATION

The gradual growth of the institute has been enhanced based on the roots of intense research. It sought the services of highly qualified and trained personnel with a psycho-dynamic approach in the medical and social sciences, viz. medicine, psychiatry, clinical psychology, sociology, neurosciences, education and psychiatric social work.

RESEARCH AND STUDY

A survey was conducted by Ms. Prachi Sharma, Faculty of Rehabilitation Psychology at the institute to understand gender ratio among reported cases at the OPD of the institute with reference to disability. Data from last two consecutive years reveal that male population have registered double in comparison to female population. The population reported at the OPD consists of infants, children, adolescents and adults.

NIHAL MOHAMMADSHEREIF SHEIKH born on 19TH MARCH 1995 is diligent and industrious. Despite being diagnosed with Mild Intellectual Disability, Nihal completed his SSE and got training at ITI. He reported to B.MInstitute of Mental Health in the beginning of 2017 with complaints related to workplace adjustment. He stays in a nuclear family with his parents and two siblings.



Structured training and rehabilitation program was designed to develop his strengths. Team of multidisciplinary experts constantly worked with him to minimize his weaknesses. Over a period of one year, Nihal developed occupational efficiencies, started performing tasks systematically taking responsibilities with proper time management and independent living skills. Finally, with the collective efforts of Professionals at B.MInstitute and his parents, Nihal got an opportunity to live a life with dignity.
